

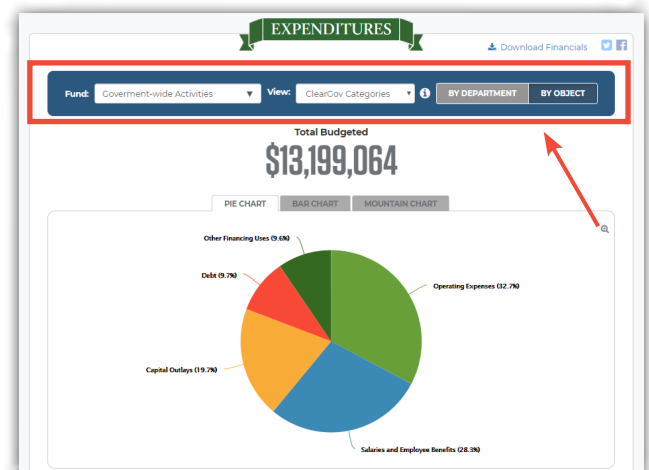

View Objects or Departments

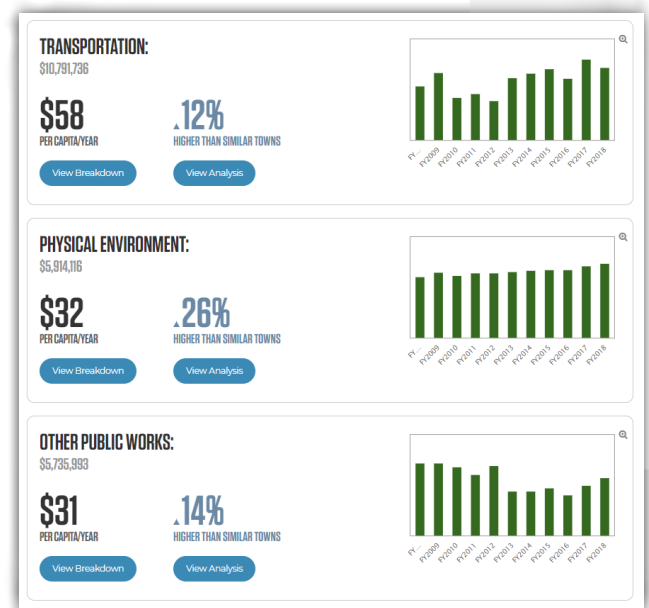
Over the coming weeks, your transparency profile will be updated so visitors have the option to view revenues and expenditures by object (e.g. salaries) or by department (e.g. Public Safety).^{*} When looking at revenues, the Objects toggle will be selected by default. When looking at expenditures, the default view will be by department.



ClearGov Mapping

ClearGov Mapping is now based on a national categorization structure that is more in line with U.S. Census Bureau and state categorizations. This update will improve benchmarking with communities in other states, as well as more consistent benchmarking overall. For example, when viewers are looking at benchmarking across different communities they will see a more apples to apples comparison.

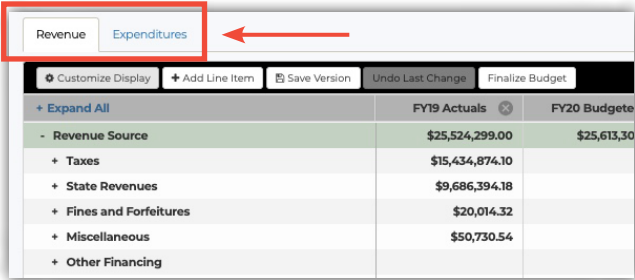
ClearGov Mapping categories enable more granular visibility into both revenue sources and expenditures. For example, Public Works has been divided into three top-level groupings: Transportation, Physical Environment (water, sewer, sanitation, etc.) and Other Public Works. With this new change there will be less drilling down through groupings to see many categories of interest.

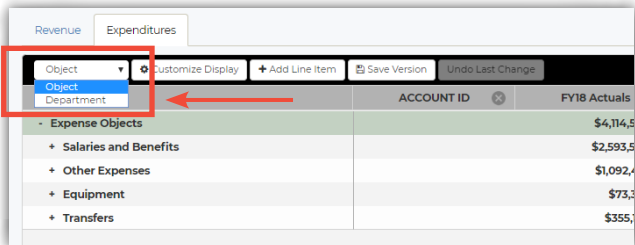
Revenue and Expenditures Tabs
